Integrity

- Be honest, fair, reliable and transparent.
- Avoid conflicts of interest.
- Strive to earn and maintain community trust.
- Don't engage in, or advocate possession or use of banned performance enhancing or illicit drugs.
- Don't participate in, or encourage match-fixing, illegal sports betting or other corruption.

Respect

- Treat everyone in a considerate, objective and courteous manner.
- Refrain from any form of discrimination, harassment, bullying, abuse, intimidation, victimisation or vilification of others.
- Recognise and value the contribution of all.

Responsibility

- Accept the consequences of your actions.
- Be a positive role model.
- Comply with child safe standards.
- Understand the consequences of breaching the Code. Report and deal with breaches.

Fairness

- Play by the rules and spirit of the game.
- Be informed, consistent, impartial, just and reasonable.
- Be a 'good sport'.
- Provide a 'fair go' to people of all abilities.

Safety

- Provide a safe, welcoming and inclusive environment.
- Ensure equipment, facilities and programs meet standards.
- Support injury management, return to play and child safe standards policies.
- Show concern and caution for others. Immediately report any issues.

Club Code of Ethics

Coaches, officials and parents, by example of behavior, hold an enormous influence over the youth of the community. The good conduct of all adult participants and teams is considered mandatory for the privilege of participation. The club seeks to implant in the youth of the community, ideas of good sportsmanship, honesty, loyalty and courage, so that they may be finer, stronger and happier youths who will grow to be good healthy adults. This objective will be pursued by providing fully supervised netball matches upon the basis that the attainment of exceptional skill or the winning of matches is secondary in the moulding of future citizens.

Players Code

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of fellow players, coaches, officials and spectators.
- Refrain from conduct which could be regarded as harassment towards fellow players and coaches.
- Do not tolerate acts of aggression.
- Respect the talent, potential and development of fellow players and competitors.
- Care for and respect the equipment provided to you as part of your program.
- Be frank and honest with your coach concerning illness and injury and your ability to train fully within the program requirements.
- Conduct yourself in a professional manner relating to language, temper and punctuality.
- Maintain high personal behaviour standards at all times.
- Abide by the rules and respect the decision of the official, making all appeals through the formal process and respecting the final decision.
- Be honest in your attitude and preparation to training. Work equally hard for yourself and your team.
- Cooperate with coaches and staff in development of programs to adequately prepare you for competition at the highest level.

Spectators Code

Be on your best behavior. Do not use profane language or harass players, coaches or officials. Applaud good plays by your team and the visiting team. Show respect for your team's opponents. Without them there would be no match. Condemn the use of violence in all forms. Respect the officials' decisions. Encourage players to always play according to the rules. Spectators are reminded that alcohol is **NOT** permitted at the court during games in accordance with Association Regulations.
